May Checklist

- Fill any bare spots on your lawn with grass seed.
- Inspect your roof for leaks and damage.
- Inspect trees to make sure branches aren't interfering with power lines.
- Inspect your attic to ensure there is enough ventilation and no hidden leaks.
- Inspect exterior caulking and replace any that is deteriorating.
- Fill cracks, caulk edges and repaint windowsills, doorsills, and thresholds as needed.
- Inspect foundation for cracks and fill them quickly.
