Extension Cord, Power Strip and Surge Protector Safety

Overloading extension cords and power strips can result in an electrical fire that may destroy your home. An extension cord with multiple outlets does not increase the limit the outlet can handle. Not all power strips are surge protectors. An overloaded surge protector will automatically cut power. A power strip will not detect an overload.

Any time that you find an outlet is hot to the touch, unplug everything and call an electrician immediately. Do not use the outlet until an electrician says it's okay to use.

Staying Safe While Using A Space Heater

Space heaters are designed to be plugged directly into an outlet or a surge protector. They should never be plugged into an extension cord or a power strip. An extension cord and power strip will heat up if used with a space heater. This increases the risk of fire.
