

What are some ways to avoid frozen pipes?

- 1.) Keep water-supplying pipes away from outside walls.
- 2.) Any pipes that are on exterior walls should be insulated.
- 3.) Any pipes in unheated areas should be insulated as well.

What do you recommend during below freezing temperatures?

- 1.) Always keep your house at a minimum of 55° Fahrenheit. Houses with less insulation may require a higher minimum temperature.
- 2.) At all times, keep all exterior doors and windows closed.
- 3.) Keep interior doors to bedrooms and bathrooms open to ensure the best heat distribution.
